Grevillea bipinnatifida x banksii

A popular, small growing shrub with spectacular, deep red flowers that appear year round. Flowers are very attractive to nectar-feeding birds. Ideal as a specimen or screening plant. Prefers an open sunny position in moist, well drained soil. Suited to low water use, small, low maintenance gardens. Tolerant of dry periods and light frost once established.
