Add usefulness and beauty, plus bird habitat, and why would you not enhance your landscape by making it even more bird-worthy? Candle Glow™ is a low to medium sized shrub, and it'll respond to any amount of pruning by crouching lower and producing even more of its lemon, sweetly perfumed brushes amongst the silver foliage. The flowers even last a while when cut for vases. Cool to sub tropical climates, full sun or light shade, and good drainage will suit; frost is no problem, and it loves coastal gardens.
