

Callistemon Cherry Time™ Callistemon subulatus x citrinus

Remember the icypoles we got on the way home from school on a hot summers day? Dripping chilled sticky red sweetness down your chin. Cherry Time™ is exactly that colour. It glows. But now its the honeyeaters turn to slurp their fill. Plant a hedge of Cherry Time™ and wait for the birdcrowd to arrive. It will grow in cool to warm climates, tolerates seasonally wet soils, moderate frost and coastal sites. Chop back after flowering finishes in late spring, and you will quadruple the quantity of flowers for next spring.
