Finding small plants which thrive in tough coastal conditions can be a challenge, and Edna Walling® Coverup™ is high on the must have list. When a plant is found naturally overlooking the ocean then you're on a winner. When it's a ground hugging sand-binder with bright yellow fan flowers most of the year you've won the Quinella. Pretty frost tolerant too, so it will grow in inland gardens as well in cool temperate to sub tropical and even semi arid climates; tough as old boots and pretty as a picture. Very low water needs and highly attractive in a hanging basket.


