



## Grevillea Bush Picnic™

*Grevillea lanigera form*

A soft-leaved lightly suckering small shrub, featuring clusters of pink & cream bird attracting flowers in winter through spring. Is fantastic as a path edging, in rockeries and containers. Great feature plant when mass planted in garden beds. Prune lightly after flowering to maintain habit; fertilise with low phosphorus native fertiliser.
